What's Happening?

- Per terms of Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) Voluntary Cleanup (VCUP), there is a period following the Neighborhood meeting on July 25 for concerned neighbors to submit questions to the engineering consultants.
- Your questions should focus on environmental concerns such as subsurface soil stability, methane gas, ground water and runoff liquids affecting Ralston Creek, etc.
- There will be an opportunity in the future to attend a Neighborhood meeting hosted by the City Planning Department to ask questions about the type of fence, landscaping, roads, lighting, hours of operation, maintenance, etc.
